

DANIEL CHAPTER 9:26-27—AFTER THE SIXTY-NINE WEEKS

1. **v. 26**—after the 69 weeks (the Triumphal Entry)
 - Messiah cut off
 - Immediately following: “trial” and crucifixion
 - Not for Himself—“there is nothing for Him”
 - He died for others
 - Nothing that rightly belonged to Him as Messiah the Prince was given to Him then
 - Sacrificial Lamb of God

2. **v.27**—people of prince...to come...destroy city and sanctuary
 - 70 AD Romans under Titus
 - All fulfilled historically (Walvoord)
 - At the end of the age Jerusalem though trodden down still exists when Christ returns in glory—Zech. 14:1-3; Rev. 11:2
 - Parenthesis (gap) between v. 26-27

3. **v.27**—The 70th Week
 - He=Prince shall come=the Antichrist
 - Confirm a covenant with the many i.e. Jews, “Your people” (v. 24)
 - 7 years guaranteeing Israel security and Middle East peace
 - Antichrist at height of powers

 - Middle of the Week-3 ½ years
 - Abomination of desolation—Mt. 24:15-16, 21; 2 Thess. 2:3-4
 - Reactivation of sacrificial system in the Temple in Jerusalem
 - Will demand worship of entire world—Rev. 13:14-17

 - Final Period of 7 years
 - Introduction of covenant between Israel—prince...come
 - Observed first half of 7 years
 - Then covenant broken by Antichrist
 - Israel—“saints” persecuted
 - Desecration of future temple
 - It is THE GREAT TRIBULATION—Rev. 6-19

 - At the End
 - Jesus Christ returns in glory
 - Is it near? Israel is back in the land
